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2. If $U = \{1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12\}$, $A = \{1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9\}$, and $B = \{2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 10, 11\}$, find $A \cup B'$. (6 points)

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3. In a survey of 527 students, we find that 320 like history courses, 288 like sociology courses, and 52 like neither. How many like both? Draw a properly labelled Venn diagram to illustrate. (7 points)
